What band courses are offered for 9th graders?



Concert Band

This is where all 9th graders begin their MHS Band experience. We work from basics review to high-level skills while enjoying a variety of band music along the way! This is a full-year course.

Marching Band-voluntary

The MHS MB is most active during the 1st marking quarter. This ensemble includes wind instruments, colorguard, and percussionists. Students begin their training with a 1-week summer “band preseason” at MHS and end their fall season with a spectacular halftime “show” presentation. *A highlight for Marching Band members is the thrill of performing the halftime show at area marching band competitions!*

Percussion Ensemble (Beg. & Adv.)

Every student percussionist will be assigned to one of these classes. The percussionists will perform in most of the Concert Band events, but the Percussion Ensemble class is all percussion, only percussion!! Students really enjoy having these classes that totally focus on their needs.



Jazz Ensemble

The Jazz Ensemble is an auditioned group. We are so pleased to offer it during the school day because it allows for greater student participation and more in-depth study. Auditions are held in the Spring. Jazz Ensemble members must also be enrolled in the Concert Band class.

...A note to parents: You will be invited to become active with the ‘Manchester Band Parents Association’ (MBPA), a great group of volunteers who make band better for all of our students!

MHS Band Frequently Asked Questions:

Q. What is the difference between Marching Band and Concert Band?

A. The Marching Band combines music with motion! The fall MB season is devoted to training students as musicians and performers to present our halftime show.

Q. How will MHS marching be different from middle school?

A. The MHS Marching Band primarily prepares for halftime performances. The middle school band usually prepares just for parade marching.

Q. Is marching band required?

A. No. Marching Band meets outside of the school day during the fall and is optional.

Q. Are there a lot of after school band activities?

A. It is seasonal. MB members are active in the fall with 2 after school practices per week (Mon. and Fri.), plus performances at football games and music festivals. Concert Band & Percussion Ensemble members are required to attend 3-4 after school (2:30-4:00) rehearsals prior to each major concert.
